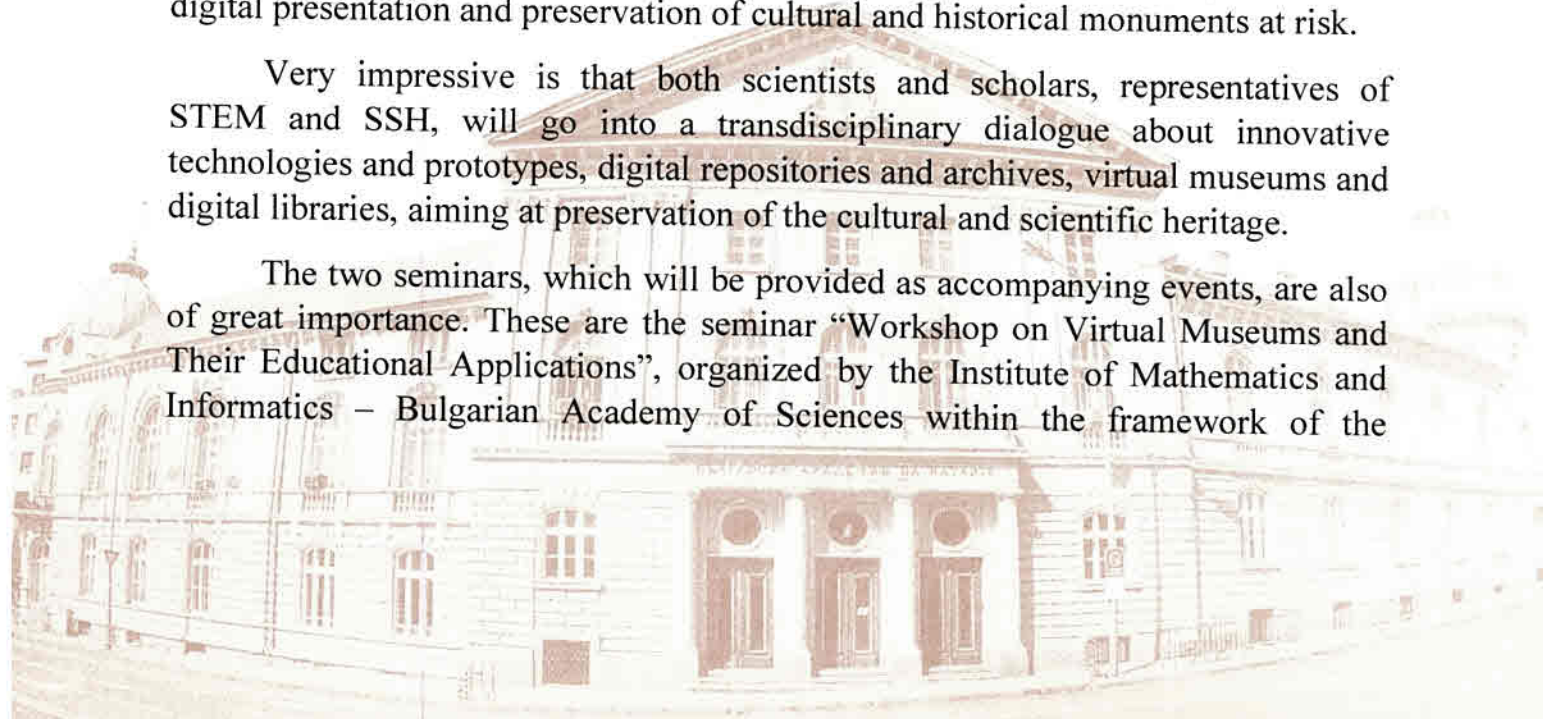
Dear colleagues,
