
There is no easy way to find digital archives related to ICH



Web Services for Cultural Heritage

Guidelines for good web services

- Realize a query parameter, to apply full text queries and specific fields queries
- Give access to a console where users can do practice with various service parameters
- Specify how to access to different multimedia files
- Give specific services to get thesaurus and tag lists (facets index)
- Examples of how to apply different types of queries








Cultural Heritage in Digital Environments (CHDE) Model

By Wijesundara & Sugimoto:

"ICH does not exist as a single physical item but is usually instantiated in many occasions"

"an ICH is not an item physically collectable by memory institutions and the item-centric resource aggregation is not suitable. *Instantiation* acts as a bridge to aggregate those resources related to intangible cultural heritage"



One-to-One principle


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
Is a long-standing principle within the Dublin Core and other cultural heritage metadata communities

It is «the principle whereby related but conceptually different entities, for example a painting and a digital image of the painting, are described by separate metadata records»


- 1. Clearly identify physical and digital objects
- 2. Key issue to aggregate metadata for a single cultural heritage object
- 3. Key issue to link item-based metadata and web resources


















Example: Bagolino Carnival
















Future developments
